To start Speedwatch up and running again, the team has to have traffic surveys done for each site that is used for recording with the camera.

The Volunteers also have to have a training session. Sarah Holden from the Police Speedwatch Team has volunteered to come out to give a training session, once the sites have been approved. Councillor Sharp has taken the opportunity to update the positioning of sites following WC guidelines. Some of the existing sites have not recorded a high degree of speed, but other places have been identified by through the Speed Indicator Devices.
