Councillor Suleman attended the December LHFIG meeting – discussions regarding Greenhill Crossroads - Councillor Suleman reported back to Clerk:

Wiltshire Council's Principle Engineer (Steve Hind) said everything possible that could be done was in place. Although road markings could be repainted and the rumble strip renovated. The only other thing to be considered was to install a Speed Indicator Device (SID). Steve Hinds was advised the Parish Council had mobile SID's – he suggested aa post could be installed. The Council needs to advise We need to go back to Steve and let him know what we want to do. He will also investigate where the SID could be located.

Clerk's Comments

The next LHFIG meeting is on the 22nd February 2023.

I have contacted the Principle Engineer, asking for confirmation of what the contribution is for and for an estimate of the amount. The response is a contribution of 25% for installation of a removable post and socket for the SID. I have not had a response regarding the renewing of road markings and rumble strip as yet.

Recommendation

Members to CONSIDER:

- making a request for a traffic survey metro count
- making a maximum contribution of £200 for the removable post and socket for a Speed Indicator Device met from the Funds set aside for LHFIG projects, totalling £4,000.
