Community Safety Forum

The speaker at the January Community Safety Forum was the Inspector i/c control room. He gave an interesting talk on the working of the 101 system and the problems they have had. The speaker next month is from the PCCs office specifically about speeding. If anyone has any question they would like me to ask please let me know.

Speed Indication Devices (SID's)

Over the last week I have taken readings from the SIDs m/c we have situated at Greatfield and also completed traffic counts at Greenhill crossroads. The information has been analysed for me by Phil Shepherd and I include the findings here:

TRAFFIC VOLUME AT LYDIARD MILLICENT CROSSROADS

The Parish Council carried out a traffic survey at the Lydiard Millicent crossroads for a nine-day period between the hours of 07:30 and 19:30 each day in mid-January 2022.

During the period of the survey the weekday Monday to Friday traffic levels were 442 vehicles per hour average, and a peak in the middle part of the day of 551 per hour average.

At the weekend the volume of traffic reduced as would be expected, the figures being 430 for Saturday with a peak during the middle part of the day of 454, and 406 for Sunday with a peak of 430.
