

Members are requested to:

- CONSIDER meeting content, delegate elements to Councillors and agree proposed clubs and groups approached to provide reports to the meeting.

The Annual Parish Meeting is called and run by the Chairman of the Parish Council. It is open to all electors of the Parish, who have the right not only to attend but also to speak on any matter of local interest. The meeting has to be held between 1st March and 1st June.

At the May 2021 Parish Council meeting it was agreed that the meeting would be held on 26th May 2022 but we have now discovered that the Parish Hall had not been booked and is no longer available on that evening. For this reason, we are suggesting that the Annual Parish Meeting is held immediately before the Annual Parish Council Meeting on the same evening.

Recommendations are that the meeting should be not to be longer than 2.5 hours. The suggested start time is 6pm with refreshments first. Reports from the Council should be on the Council's achievements in 2021-22 financial year and its visions for 2022-2023.

We are proposing that the Parish Meeting starts at 5:45 with Parishioners invited to join Councillors for tea/coffee followed by the meeting itself at 6pm. The Annual Parish Council meeting needs to start no later than 7:30pm if possible. The recommendation is that we aim to have presentations and reports for the Parish Meeting for about an hour to give time for Parishioners to discuss/ask questions etc. Parishioners will then be able to leave or stay for the Parish Council meeting.

The Council will need to advertise the meeting to households in the parish which can be via leaflets or local magazine. The Council also needs to send invitations to local organisations and groups to come along. This will be a follow on meeting to "Meet the Councillors" therefore we should update on what has happened since that meeting.
