Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Closure of: Hook Street (Part), Lydiard Tregoze (Ref: TTRO 6499)

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic:

Hook Street (Part), Lydiard Tregoze; from its junction with Bridleway 13, Lydiard Tregoze for a distance of approximately 310 metres in an easterly direction.

To enable: Re-Beding of steel cattle grids and surface water drainage investigation works.

Alternative route: via Hook Street (unaffected length) – Out of the County – C28 – C414 and vice versa.

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.

This Order will come into operation on 04 May 2020 and the closure will be required between the hours of 09:30 and 15:00 for one day. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.
