Background

At the Jubilee Club House, there are currently only a few mismatched mugs in the kitchen and an old kettle. To encourage use of the facilities it is proposed that we purchase a set of matching crockery, of a type that we can replace items if they are broken or damaged and purchase additional items if required.

Initially, we would purchase 48 each of large plates, small plates, bowls, mugs, cups, saucers and spoons plus tea pot, coffee pot, milk jugs and sugar bowls. Additionally, we would look to purchase a continuous fill hot water urn to make it easier to produce tea and coffee in volume.

Initial costings suggest that the crockery would cost approximately £500 and the urn £300. Proposal is for £1,000 to be allocated to cover the cost of these items plus the cost of a Plumber to connect the urn.
