

Lydiard Millicent Neighbourhood Watch, SIDs and Speedwatch Report.

1. SIDs report.

PC Turner, Traffic Police has been supplied with readings from the device situated at The Beeches during July. During September he has carried out speed checks twice at this location stopping several vehicles and issuing fines and points on a couple of occasions. One of our devices has been moved to monitor Lydiard Green at The Beeches at his request.

2. Speedwatch Report.

Alan Pflieger, Speedwatch co-ordinator has at last received a hand-held speed camera from the police Speedwatch team. Two operators carried out checks at The Beeches on Tuesday 28th September and only recorded 2 violations during 45 minutes. It is hoped to have regular checks at the authorised sites from now on.

3. Neighbourhood Watch.

A report has been received from PCSO Singfield.

“Since the last Parish report transport incidents remain our highest statistic, we (Roads Policing unit and Community Policing teams) have arrested 8 drink/drug drivers and seized 5 vehicles without insurance in the past months which is why our figures haven’t really changed.

I will be tutoring a new PCSO for the next 6 weeks so will be splitting my time between my area and Malmesbury where she will be based, with the nights drawing in and the clocks changing this month we may see an increase in burglaries so please as I said last month be vigilant and take any precautions you can as always please feel free to E-mail me and I’ll get back to you as soon as I practically can.”

I will be sending a reminder on Facebook and e-mail in the next couple of weeks to be extra vigilant with winter approaching and to make sure all sheds and outbuildings and garages are secured.
