

Members are requested to:

- NOTE this report and information
- CONSIDER the quote for the installation of a swing height restrictor
- CONSIDER the installation of removable bollards

Agreed at the last Parish Meeting at Minute Reference

Members AGREED that the existing gate would stay in position as a trial.

Following discussions, it was AGREED:

- to investigate further the purchase and installation of a height restrictor, Councillor Hacker to work with the Handyman and one other Councillor to look at in more detail the proposal.
- Set a maximum budget of £4,000 for the purchase and installation of a height restrictor barrier – met from CIL funds
- As the final specification and/or restrictions may not be as described in the report, an Extraordinary meeting would be called, if the specification and costs are received before the next scheduled meeting

Further Information

Councillor Hacker and Sharp together with the Handyman, met with a company who specialist in the installation of height restrictors. The Clerk made enquiries but some could only provide or install not complete the requirements of the Council or in the timeframe required. The following information is the specific specification and costs as requested at the last Parish meeting

Quote Details

This barrier is a reliable and robust height restriction barrier. An ideal solution to prevent unauthorised access to higher vehicles to areas such as car parks, shopping centres or recreational grounds.

To supply and install a restrictor barrier with latch post, sign and combination lock, as shown below.

Specification: Uprights 100 x 100 x 3mm Box Section, Crossbar 80 x 80 x 3mm Box Section, Concrete In - 760mm Below Ground, Gate has 180 degree opening, depending on hinge post positioning, Other powder coating colours available on request, Signage will read "Maximum Height 2.1 Metres", Lock Shrouds will be manufactured on to the closing post as standard
At a cost of £2103.00 (ex VAT)



Members to CONSIDER and APPROVE whether they wish to install a height restrictor at the main gate to the Jubilee Club House at a cost of £2,103 (ex VAT) from CIL funds

Field Access – Removable Bollards

It has been put forward to give some protection to the field, that the posts could be reinstalled at the vehicle service point between the JCH building and the start of the car park

A maximum of three stainless removable bollards could be placed here at a distance of 1.2 metres apart. They are ram proof and easy to remove for maintenance purposes and for emergency situations that may arise.
