Background

Extract of the minutes from the Parish meeting held on 22 June 2022

22.46 Members NOTED the report from the Clerk and Councillor Allsop, and considered the recommendation to purchase new noticeboards to enable the Council to reach more of its residents. Two small noticeboards already located at the Cemetery and JCH will be relocated, with larger ones purchased to replace. A further small noticeboard to be purchased, with the three sited at Greenhill, Greatfield and Common Platt. The style would be the same as those purchased previously. Following discussions, Members RESOLVED with one abstention, to set a budget of £2000 (two thousand pounds) funded by CIL Funds. This provision falls within the Community Infrastructure levy criteria as it is helping with the community's infrastructure by communication with residents. DELEGATED to Councillor Allsop, the Handyman and Clerk

Update

Councillor Allsop, the Clerk and Handyman looked at the options available and the noticeboard legs held in stock. Following exchanges of emails with the agreed supplier, it was confirmed that the legs held in stock would not support the larger noticeboard. After discussions, it was also thought that the board at the Cemetery should be of the same shape and design as that at the front of the Parish Hall. This style would accommodate the Cemetery regulations but also allow for other information the Council wants to disseminate to residents.

Recommendation

To purchase a different style and slightly larger board (additional £452.22) (same as located in front of the Parish Hall) and to purchase new board legs (£236.78), increase delivery charge of £40 at a total cost of £729, cost to be met from CIL Funds.
